

388 This Indenture made this 30th day of October 1809 between Benjamin Barbee of the State of South Carolina & Greenville District of the one part and Them Carney of the same place, of the other part, Witneseth that the sd Barbee for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the sd them Carney the Receipt of which the said Barbee doth hereby acknowledge that he hath granted bargained & by these presents doth grant bargain & sell & confirm unto the said them Carney his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of land containing one hundred fifty acres more or less being part of a tract granted to Uriah corner situate in Greenville District south side of Encoee River, Beginning on hickory on Kemp's branch running up said branch bounded with land laid out for George Russell cornering on a black oak, running up a little branch to a stake thence a S.W. course to a hickory thence running S. course to a poplar corner on the main branch thence down said branch to where it empties into the Cainlakie branch the course of the branch down to a dogwood corner thence a wt. course to a black oak corner thence a S. course to a pine from the pine corner to a little branch up said branch to a maple corner thence to a tottie oak stake thence to S. Beginning corner on a Hickory: With all and singular the woods & waters courses & the said Benjamin Barbee do warrant & forever defend from myself my heirs and assigns and all other lawful claims whatsoever unto the said them Carney his heirs & assigns forever, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand, and in the presence of us -
