State of South Carolina This Indenture made the twelfth day of March  
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten and in the thirty fourth  
year of American Independence between Henry Tracy Walker Sheriff of Greenville  
District in the State aforesaid of the one part, and William Brown & Horatio Griffin  
Merchants of the State & District aforesaid of the other part, Whereas Thomas Forrester  
of the State and District aforesaid was lately seized in his demesne as of fee, or of  
and in some good and lawfull estate of inheritance to him and his heirs and assigns  
forever and proper of the plantation, Lands Tenements & hereditaments hereby conveyed  
and intended to be herein after more particularly mentioned and described, Whereas  
also Horatio Griffin & William Brown otherwise called Griffin Brown Merchants did  
lately that is to say on or about the fourth day of April in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and nine before the Justices of the Court of Common Pleas  
held at Greenville Courthouse in and for the district of Greenville in the State  
aforesaid before the Justices of the said Court duly obtained and entered up judgment  
against the said Thomas Forrester for the sum of Two hundred and eighty Dollars  
and ninety cents and interest thereon from the

and also for the sum of forty two Dollars and thirty one &  $\frac{1}{2}$  cents for their costs  
and charges by them expended in & about prosecuting their suit in that behalf  
as in and by the said judgment & other Proceedings duly entered up Remainings of Record in  
the office of the Clerk of the said Court at Greenville Courthouse aforesaid (whereas being there  
had) will more fully appear, And whereas in pursuance of said Judgment there was  
served out of said Court of Common Pleas a certain writ of fieri facias dated at Greenville  
Courthouse aforesaid on the first Monday of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and nine and in the thirty third year of American Independence directed to  
all and singular the Sheriffs of the said State commanding them and each of them without  
delay that of the goods & chattels houses lands & other hereditaments and real estates  
of the said Thomas Forrester they or one of them should cause to be paid the aforesaid  
sum of Two Hundred and eighty Dollars & ninety cents & interest & costs as aforesaid unto  
the said Griffin and Brown in the said Court of Common Pleas at Greenville Courthouse  
aforesaid recovered against the said Thomas Forrester whereof the said Thomas Forrester
