sterling money to me in hand paid by Henry Paris of the State and District aforesaid, & for certain
other good causes moving me thence have given granted and sold and by these presents doth
give grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry Paris his heirs and assigns all that planta-
tion a tract of land wherein John Payne now lives containing Seventy four acres (be the same more
or less) of land it being part of a tract of one hundred and seventy four acres of land purchased
of Ruben Coopland and having such shape four & marks as more fully appears by reference to
to the original Plat. Together with all and singular the right, estates & profits thereto
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all & singular the
said premises to him the said Henry Paris his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said
John Payne Sen^r doth bind myself my heirs and executors to warrant and forever defend
the said tract of Seventy four acres of land (be the same more or less) unto him the said Henry
Paris his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs, and against every other person or persons
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - And also the
whole of my goods and chattels to be the right title and estate of the said Henry Paris
his heirs and assigns forever. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
my seal this first Day of June eighteen hundred and eleven and of the Independence
of the United States of America the thirty fifth - Signed Sealed & Delivered in the
presence of Rob^t Elgin, Elizabeth Paris, Sarah Paris ^{mark} John ^{his} Payne ^{mark}
