

that I Lewis Willis Greenlee of the state and district aforesaid for and in Considera-
tion of the sum of Two hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Charles
Maxwell of Greenville district in the state aforesaid have granted bargained
and sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell & Release unto the
said Charles Maxwell a certain tract or parcel of land, situated and lying
in Greenville district on the waters of the Saluda River & Saluda River
Beginning at a stake & thence S 54 E 47 chains 50 links to a stake & on John
Bowie's line thence S 30 W. to a Post oak & from thence N 80 W. 55 chains to a
stake & on Salyers line from thence S 18 W. 58 chains to a stake & on Saluda River
from thence up the said River to Obadiah Hudson's corner on a stake, from
thence N 40 E. 48 chain, 50 links to the Beginning & on John Maxwell's line
Containing one hundred and twenty six acres and three fourths (as the
plot represents) being part of a tract of land originally surveyed for Ambrose
Blackburn & James Harrison granted and dated the fifth day of September
one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven, and Conveyed by them to
Crafford Goodwyn Together with all and singular the rights members heredi-
taments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
appertaining, To have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Charles Maxwell his heirs Executors administrators and assigns
forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto
the said Charles Maxwell his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs
and against every person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
same or any part thereof, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this 28th day of February one thousand eight hundred and nine and in the
thirty fourth of the Independence of the United States of America — Signed sealed
