stake st Bounding on John Hollands land, thence 1.80 E. 5.00 to a red oak st thence 1.12 N. 3.50 to a
stake st thence 1.63 E. 25.00 to a Post oak st all bounding on William Stones land thence
N. 43 E. 13.50 to a small hickory st bounding on the said George Grace thence N. 95 W. 30.
.00 to a Rock st near a branch bounding on Alexander Acker, thence 1.60 N. 10.50 to a Red
oak sapling thence N. 78 W. 10.50 to a Persimmon st on a branch bounding on John Hollands
thence down the meanders of said Branch to the Beginning; Together with all and singular
the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
wise incident or pertaining, To have & To hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Loving Ross his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby
