The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Timothy Chandler of Greenville district and state aforesaid in consideration of Two hundred Dollars to me paid by Micajah Stone of Greenville district in the state of aforesaid, Have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Micajah Stone all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred acres be the same more or less, situate in Greenville District lying on mountain creek waters of Saluda Beginning on a spanish oak 34 at the mouth of the long branch nearly a North course 28:00 up the meander of said branch to an ash 34 thence S. 65 N. 7:00 to a spanish oak 34 thence N. 8 W. 30:00 to a white oak 34 bounding on Charly Easter Juns land, thence S. 8 N. 1 to a post oak 34 thence S. 6:50 to a Red oak 34 thence S. 70 N. 6:50 to an ash 34 at the head of a branch thence down the meander of said branch to its confluence with mountain creek thence down the meander of said creek to the Beginning
