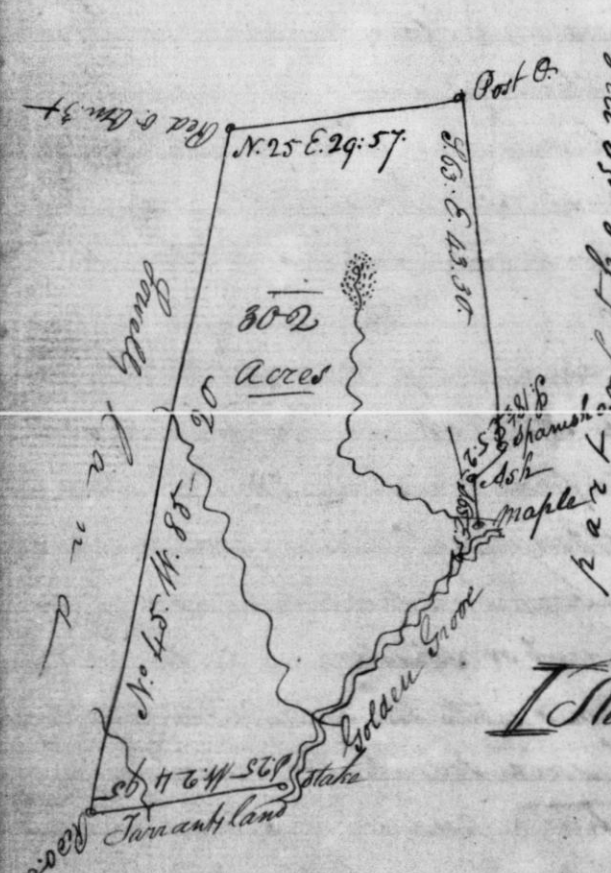

 oned and released Given under my hand and seal this twenty first day of September AD. 1812. (Sd) Elisha Green J.D. Christian Thompson

South Carolina Greenville District Personally came Hardy S. Gibreath before me the subscribing Justice and being duly sworn maketh oath that he saw Capt. Josiah Thompson sign seal and deliver the within deed of Conveyance to Jeremiah Cleveland for the use and purposes therein mentioned, and that John Hall & Robert W. Briggs were subscribing witnesses with himself to the same Sworn to and subscribed by me this 21<sup>st</sup> day of Sept. 1812.
