Know all men by these presents that I George Underwood of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Jacob Smith Rhody of the district and State aforesaid, Have granted bargain sold and released unto the said Jacob Smith Rhody a part of a tract or parcel of land wherein the said George Underwood now lives containing five hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less being part of a tract of land originally granted to John Watson and is bounded as followeth, Beginning at a post oak bush and running thence N. 63 E. 33 chains 25 to a light wood stake corner on a Road thence S. 25 E. 54<sup>ch</sup> 77 to a post oak corner, not far from a pond thence S. 65 N. 33<sup>ch</sup> 25 to a light wood stake corner on a conditional line thence N. 25 W. 54<sup>ch</sup> 77 to the Beginning post oak bush, the same being a conditional line run by Benjamin Griffith Esq between Nimrod Underwood and the above mentioned Jacob S. Rhody Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto said Jacob Smith Rhody his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors & Administrators or assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jacob S. Rhody his heirs and assigns, against myself my heirs and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, and by these presents do warrant and forever
