him conveyed to W^m White, & from said White to myself, beginning at a R. Ok. near
the ridge road & running thence S^E 38 W 24° to a B. Ok on my line thence S^E 47 E with
said Whitters line 45° to a W. Ok near a branch thence up that branch the said
meanders near the head to a pine thence N^E 40 E 8° 50' to a chestnut on another line of
