Twenty five dollars to me paid by Joel Allison of the state & District aforesaid have
granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant Bargain, sell
and release unto the said Joel Allison a plantation & part of a tract of land that
was originally granted to Hendrik Arnold for 517 acres by a grant bearing date 1st
day of June 1790. Then conveyed by different conveyances to s^d Mullican & W. W. Allison
part of the tract Beginning on a branch on Little Horse Creek the water of ready runs
Running thence S²⁰ W⁵⁵ Ch^l to a post oak thence N³⁷ E¹⁵ 75. to a stake thence N⁶
65 E⁸ Ch^l to a stake thence N⁵ E¹⁸ to a white oak thence N³ E³⁵ 50. down the Meadow
a branch to Little horse Creek thence up the Meanders of S^d Creek to the Beginning
including the plantation wheron the s^d Mullican now living together with one.
