convey to Waddy Thompson a certain tract of Land situate lying & being in
the district & state aforesaid containing two hundred & fifty ^{acres} more or less
bounded by lands originally granted to James Blasingame & Nathaniel
Bondeator, & by lands now in the possession of Josiah Thomson & John Jones
and whereas the said Mary Somerlin & Waddy Thompson have mutually
consented to rescind the aforesaid ^{bargain} & Sale. Now I know all men by these presents
that I the said Waddy Thompson do hereby reconvey to the said Mary
Somerlin, all the right little & interest of mine in & unto the said tract or
^{parcel} of land which she convey'd to me, in as full & ample a manner as if the said
tract of land had never been convey'd to me. In witness whereof
