Chains 50 links to a white pine thence N. 33 W 3 chains to a chestnut thence N.
35. W. 25 chains to a hickory by a dog wood & a large red oak thence N. 70 E.
79 chains to a white pine thence S. 45 E. 51. Chains to a Stake thence to the begin
ning containing by estimation Three Hundred & Forty four acres from Robert
Smith to Alexander Stevenson, from Stevenson to William Young, from Young
to James Young, from James Young to Alexander Cunningham and to Richard
Ward, with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments & appurta
nances to said Land and premises belonging or in any wise incident or appur
taining, To have and to hold all & singular the Land and premises before
mentioned unto the said Richard Ward his heirs and assigns forever
