The State of S: Carolina Greenville District, Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Edwards of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of four hundred dollars to me in hand Paid by William Edwards Wickliff of the <sup>State</sup> District aforesaid have Granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said W<sup>m</sup> E. Wickliff all that Tract or parcel of land I Purchased of George Garrison which land being and lying in Greenville District and state aforesaid and on the waters of the called a river and the long branch of Ready river containing four hundred and seventy nine acres be the same more or less which land was granted to James Pitt by his excellency William Moultrie which land was conveyed from said Pitt to George Garrison and from Garrison to Edwards which will more fully appear by the Records of Greenville the land Bounded as followeth Beginning on a Post Oak Corner near the road leading from Greenville Courthouse to Parrises ford on Saluda river Running thence So 47 E. 22 Ch<sup>g</sup> to an oak on the side of a hill on Bensons land, thence N 74 E. 31 ch<sup>g</sup> 85 links to a post oak on General Basingame's line, thence S. 51 E. 23 ch<sup>g</sup> 85 links to a Pine on Blasingame's line, thence N 34 E. 54 chains to a Stake on Pitt's line thence N 44 W. 95 ch<sup>g</sup> to a Chestnut on the side of a Road from thence to the beginning, Containing four hundred & Seventy Nine acres more or less, together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments & appertinence to the <sup>3d</sup> premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the <sup>3d</sup> William Edwards Wickliff his heir or assigns for ever & I do bind myself my heir executors & to warrant & forever defend the <sup>3d</sup> land from me and my heirs and from every other Person or Persons lawfully claiming or to blame the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this Sixth Day June 1814.
