

317 Greenville Courthouse, known and distinguished in the Plan or Chart of said Village by the number of five and six (5&6) being the north end of said two Lots N<sup>o</sup>. (5&6) begining on a Stake corner running thence N<sup>o</sup> 15 $\frac{1}{2}$  degrees East one hundred feet to a Stake corner, thence S<sup>o</sup> seventy four and a half degrees East two hundred & fifty two & half feet to a Stake corner, thence S<sup>o</sup> fifteen & a half degrees West one hundred feet to a Stake corner, thence N<sup>o</sup> Twenty four "degrees & a half West one hundred & fifty two feet & a half to the begining - Supposed to contain one acre (more or less) part of Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 5 was conveyed to John Ayres Deceased by John M. Clananhan and the said part of lot N<sup>o</sup>. 6 was conveyed to said John Ayres deceased by said John M. Clananhan. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining therewards To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Brittenden his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors administrators and assigns to warrant and forewarrant all and singular the said premises unto the said John Brittenden his heirs &c. against us & our heirs & against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that I W<sup>m</sup> Grant of the State and District aforesaid for in consideration of the sum of six hundred Dollars to me in hand Paid by Maysey Borensmith of the said state and District have granted Bargained and sold and by presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Maysey Borensmith Two certain tracts or parcels of land the two containing Two hundred Acres more or less situated and lying in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid and on the south fork of those forks on Tyger river the larger tract containing one hundred and seventye five Acres was land granted to W<sup>m</sup> Benson by his Excellency Benjamin Gervord Esqr by a Grant bearing date the fifteenth of Octo. A.D one thousand seven hundred and eighty four, Bounding S E on lands laid out to Robt. Goodlett all other sides on vacant lands at the time of the original Survey there of being made, which said Survey calls for two hundred acres, but by reason
