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South Carolina Greenville Know all men by these presents that I Arthur Clerk of the state and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by John Corr of said State and District have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Corr all that parcel or tract of land containing one hundred acres more or less situate on the north side of Saluda river in the State and District aforesaid beginning at a red ^{oak} tree on the bank of said river running N 70 E with my own line 7ch to a red oak 3x thence S 59 E still with said line 5 ch. 75 L to a Post oak 3x, thence N 70 E along said line 48 ch to a Post oak 3x thence N 59 W 5 ch. 75 L to a Stone 3x where it intersects W. Bowens line, then S 70 W with said Bowens line 24 ch. to a red oak 3x thence N 15 W with said line 31 ch. 20 L to a Post oak 3x thence S 70 W still with said Bowens line 25 ch. 50 L to a red oak 3x on the bank of said river, thence down the meanders of said river to the begining Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertances therunto belonging or in anywise incident to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said John Corr his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and so ever defend
