3x thence S 60° W 30" to a hickory 3x bounding on said Hamiltons Lands, thence S 20° 13' 50"
to the begining bounding on John Thonars lands Together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments and appertanances to the said premises belonging or in anywise
incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said William Arnold his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself
my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said William Arnold his heirs and assigns against
