Know all men by these Presents that I David Davenport of the district and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars, to me in hand paid by Warren Clappsey of the same place have bargained sold and delivered and by these Presents do bargain sell and deliver unto the said Warren Clappsey two feather beds of furniture seven head of Hogs, my Plantation tools, Household, and Kitchen furniture of every description; To have and to hold the same in Trust, to & for the following use and purpose, to wit, for the sole benefit of my wife Nancy Davenport; And I do hereby authorise Constitute & appoint my said Wife Nancy Davenport, a free and sole dealer, to bind herself by her Contracts, and make her property liable for the same. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 31st of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & fourteen. Signed Sealed & delivered in presence of David Davenport
