432 This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of March one thousand eight hun
dred and eleven between Asa Sampford of the district of Greenville in the State
of South Carolina of the one part, and Joshua Thompson of the district and State
aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Asa Sampford for and in
consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars to him in hand well &
truly paid, at and before the signing and delivery of these presents by the said Joshua
Thompson, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by the said Asa
Sampford Doth grant bargain sell alien release and confirm, and by these
Presents Doth grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said
Joshua Thompson his heirs and assigns forever, The following tract or parcels
of land (to wit) Imprimis one tract of land situate lying and being
in the district and State aforesaid, containing one hundred acres be the same
more or less, granted by James Hilde to the said Asa Sampford by his deed bearing
date the thirteenth day of October One thousand eight hundred and eight.
Recorded in the Office of Mesne Conveyance of the said district on the thirteenth

day of October 1810 and certified by G.W. Earle Register of the same.
the said hundred acres being a part of three hundred acres originally granted
unto John Lafferty and signed by his excellency Thomas Pinckney on the sixth
day of October one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight, as by a P.L.C.
Clement will more fully appear, and laid unto the said Asa Sampford
as follows. Beginning at a dead oak on the North side of Quart branch
and running nearly South to a Pine knot corner on Jacob Black's corner
thence on the original line to the corner, thence on the original line to the said
Quart branch, thence up the said branch to the beginning conditional corner.
