the River to a poplar corner made by Samuel Gordon thence down the  
Meadow to a post oak corner thence across the River to a Road leading from  
the said Gordon to a stone old place on the Ridge Road then to a corner  
on a Red oak, thence along the said Road to a corner on a Spanish oak  
thence to the Beginning, together with all and singular the Rights  
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
or in any wise incident or appertaining, I do Have and do Hold all and  
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John P. Benson  
his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and  
singular the said land and premises unto the said John P. Benson  
his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs or any other  
person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same

on the East side of the old Road thence to a white oak on the bank of  
the River near said Benson's bridge thence down the different meadows  
of the said River to the beginning, it being a part of tract of land laid out  
for William & Samy Subbly and granted to Robert Prince. Together with all  
and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining  
I do Have and do Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
