The said Crenshaw to have the Equity of Redemption that is to say by paying and discharging the said sum of one hundred and seventy seven dollars and fifty cents over by the twenty third day of January 1817 then this Mortgage to be void, otherwise the fore-mentioned of the same to be carried into effect. Given under my hand and Seal this 23rd January 1816.

Personally came Sally Lester before me and made oath as the Law directs that she was present and did see Pleasant Crenshaw sign, seal and deliver the within ~~mortgage~~ mortgage for the purpose therein contained and that she also saw Paschal Rutledge sign the same with her self. Know all men by these presents that I Joshua Hawkins of Greenville District and State aforesaid in consideration of three hundred dollars to me paid by Samy Robertson of the distict and State aforesaid have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Samy Robertson all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres lying on Armstrong's Creek Beginning on a stake on Samy Robertson's line thence to a Spanish oak above, thence along Reasoning line to a white oak corner then up a small branch to Reasoning the Beginning corner be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samy Robertson his heirs and assigns forever. I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Samy Robertson his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every Person or Persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same for any part thereof.
