up the fork of said branch to a rock corner thence S. 30° E. 27' on Daniel
Hicks land to Stake corner, thence S. 25° E. 10' to the begining. Together
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments to the said
premises belonging or in any wise incident therunto to have and
to hold all and singular before mentioned premises unto the said
Walter Ashmore his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby
bind myself my heirs &c to warrant and ever defend all and
singular the premises unto the said Walter Ashmore his heirs &
assigns &c against myself my heirs assigns & all other persons
lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. Given un-

in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand
paid by Joseph Kelly of the State and County aforesaid have granted
bargained sold and ... by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto Joseph Kelly a part of two tracts of land, the one being originally
granted to Ramsey on the fourth day of December 1786 the other being
originally to Seffie Green on the third day of August 1801 Situate and
lying in the district of on branch of Keedy River containing seventy
acres of land to the same more or less, beginning on a post oak 63 & one
direct line between said Kelly and Adam Barrell, land running
thence N 17° Chain to pine corner thence N 9 W 16 Chain to a white
oak Conditional corner, thence a strate line to a Chestnut corner
thence up the big Branch to Willis Hicks corner thence along
S. line to a conditional corner, thence South 46 W. to a post oak.
