


State of South Carolina Greenville District. Know all men by

 grant Bargain Sell and release unto the all that tract supposed  
 to contain two hundred and eight Acres be the same more or  
 less Situated in the district and State aforesaid on a small branch  
 off Durbans creek waters of Enoree River Beginning at P.O. 3X on  
 Stephen Howard land & runs N 42 E 27 to 89 3X thence S 46 E 15 to a Hickory  
 3X on the North Side of the Charleston Waggon Road thence up the  
 meanders of Said Road to Kilgoes P.C. corner on the South Side of  
 Said Road thence along S. Kilgoes line N 02 W 25 to a R. 0. 3X  
 thence S 30 W 95.50 to a R 0 3X and the S. 35 E 69 to the beginning  
 Post oak corner which includes the full land to be conveyed be  
 the same more or less Together with all and Singular the rights men  
 ber hereditaments and appurtenances unto the Said premises belonging  
 or in any wise incident or appertaining unto the Said William N  
 Craggs his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself  
 my heirs executors Administrators & assigns to warrant and for  
 ever defend the above described premises unto the Said William  
 N Craggs, his heirs executors administrators & assigns forever ago  
 inst, my self my heirs executors administrators & assigns & against any  
 other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
 the same or any part thereof In Witness whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand and seal the 25 day of January in the year of our  
 Lord 1815.
