Stephen Howard of Greenville District and State aforesaid for & in
consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars to me in hand
paid by William M. Crymes of the State and district aforesaid
have bargained sold released and conveyed & by these presents do
Bargain Sell and convey unto the said William M. Crymes a certain
tract or parcel of land whereon Tho Austin now lives Containing one
hundred & forty six acres to the same more less the land to be conveyed
is part of a tract of two hundred and thirteen acres conveyed from Thomas
Key to Stephen Howard by conveyance bearing date 13th March 1801.
which said two hundred and thirteen acres is part of a tract of six hundred
and forty acres granted to Daniel Wight by Patent grant bearing
date 5th Dec^r 1791 by his excellency Charles Pinckney Governor of the
State aforesaid; the Land to be conveyed to the said Crymes -
is situate lying and being in the district and State aforesaid, on
a small branch of big Durbin Creek Waters of the Eno river
beginning on a black Gum corner 3x old Gum \$36 E 44 chains to
a Blk. C. 34 old, thence N 42 E 38 chains to a Pine 3x old, thence N.
38 W. 45.50 to a black Gum 3x new - thence \$38 W. 33 chain to the
beginning corner, which include the land to be conveyed.
Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments,
and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise incident
or appertaining unto the said William M. Crymes, his heirs,
executors, Administrators and assigns, forever. & I do hereby
bind myself my heirs executors Administrators or assigns to
warrant and forever defend the above described premises unto the
said William M. Crymes, his heirs executors administrators or
assigns forever against myself my heirs executors administrators
or assigns or against any other person or persons whomsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part

seal this 24th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand and Eighty
