 These presents that I John Thomas of Greenville District and State aforesaid
 For and in consideration of the sum of fourteen hundred dollars to me
 in hand paid by Stutl Thuston of The said State & district aforesaid have
 Granted Bargained Sold and Released and By these Presents do grant
 Bargain sell and Release unto the said Stutl Thuston all the tracts
 or Parcels of Land Whereon I Now lie by adjoining the same and
 bounded as followeth beginning on a gum corner on the south side of
 South tyed river running thence S. E. just along Robert Carters line of the
 same tract to a Stake in a Place of Cleared Ground, thence S. E. East the
 Out line of Parsons original Survey crossing Clear Creek five times
 to a dead hickory corner of the originally Survey, thence N. E. East to the river
 containing three hundred acres more or less it being part of a tract of land
 originally granted to Mayflower Parsons by his Excellency Benjamin Gunn
 Bearing date the twenty first day of January one thousand seven
 hundred and eightye five which land was conveyed from Parsons to Todd
 from Todd to John Thomas and from John Thomas to his grand son John Thomas
 as by the Record will more fully & at large appear. Also one other Tract or
 Parcel of land containing two acres that the said Thomas purchased
 of William King adjoining the above described Tract beginning where
 William King lies across Clear Creek opposite Thomas old field a
 small distance above the old waggon road Running up the meander
 of the S. E. Creek to a white oak from thence to the beginning Reference
 to the Record will more fully & at large appear. Also one other tract
 or parcel of land lying where the saw mill now stands, supposed to be sit
 & severous and lying near the said mill house or adjoining, which land
 was willed to the said John Thomas, By his uncle Wm D Thomas
 as by Reference to the will more fully appears containing ~~one~~

 Executors Administrators &c to warrant & forever defend the aforesum
 entioned & above described Land unto the said Stutl Thuston & his heirs
 forever from me & my heirs & from every other person or persons whomsoever
 ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In witness
