taining Ninety one acres (be the same more or less) it being part  
of a tract originally granted to Richard Brown on the fourth day  
of December 1786 Beginning on a red oak thence N 40° 15' 20"  
to a red oak thence N 81° 49' 19" to a red oak thence S: 15° 45' 18" 20" to a  
red oak, thence S 10° E. 74. 40. to a Stake, thence S 78° E 25 to a Stake  
thence N 20° E 20 chains to the beginning including the Plan-  
tation where the said Cobb now lives, laying on the beaver  
dam Creek waters of Mountain Creek of Saluda river in the  
State and district aforesaid. Together with all & singular the  
rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.
