14¹ The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I Samuel
Morrow of Greenville district in the State aforesaid in consideration of three
hundred dollars to me paid by James Cannon a day of the State & district
aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents
do grant bargain sell & release unto the said James Cannon
all that tract or Plantation of land containing one hundred & fifty
acres be the same more or less, beginning on an ash on the branch & running
N 65 W 30 chs 75 ths to a Stake, thence N 25 E 88 chs 75 ths to a Spanish oak, then
S 28 E 4 chs . . . to a Stake thence N 85 E 10 chs 80 ths to a post oak, thence
N 25 E 12 chs 90 ths to Spanish oak, thence S 65 E 25 chs 1 to a Stake thence S 25
W 8 chs 1 to a Stake thence S 65 E 6 chs 82 ths to a post oak, thence S 25 W 28
chains to a Stake, thence S 65 E 6 chs to a white oak on the bank of the branch
thence down the meander of the branch to the Beginning, it being part of a
tract of land originally granted by His Excellency William Moultrie to Peter
Swain containing six hundred and forty acres the grant bearing date the
6th day of March 1786, & duly conveyed to Samuel Morrow and recorded
in Greenville the 25 day of February 1812 in book 8 Pages 744 & 75 it being a
branch of Cripple creek waters of Rudy River Greenville district. Soge-
ther with all & singular the rights members Hereditaments & appur-
tenances, to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
for ever and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said James Cannon his heirs & assigns forever, and I do bind myself
my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & forever defend all and
singular the said premises unto the said James Cannon his heirs & assigns
against myself & my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, witness my hand and
Seal this 12th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred & fifteen, in the fortieth year of the Independence of the United
States of America after David Morrow. Thomas Morrow. Samuel Morrow
South Carolina Greenville district personally came before me the Subscribing
Justice David Morrow who being sworn saith that he was present & saw
Samuel Morrow sign Seal & deliver the within deed of Conveyance to Jas
Cannon for the purpose therein specified sworn to & subscribed before me
this 8th January 1818 he also saith that Thomas Morrow was with himself a
Subscribing witness thereto, John H. Harrison J. P. David Morrow.
