William Jones and William Barnard Together with all
the singular the rights members Hereditaments and
Appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise Inclo-
- sent or appertaining thereunto into the only proper use
and Benefit of him the said William Barnard his heirs
Exect^r Adm^r & Assigns against my self my heirs Execut^r
and Adm^r and no wth^r as its to be understood that
said James Wilgore only sells & conveys his right Title
& Claims witness my hand & seal this 29 October 1804
and in the 29th year of the Independence of the United
States of America
