Containing fifteen acres more or less Together with all & singular
the Rights & members hereditaments & Appertanances to the said
premises Blonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining
& I do warrant & for Ever Defend the above Described land to
Benjamin Langford his heirs or assigns & against Every other
person or persons lawfully claiming or to Claim the same or
any part thereof. Witness my hand this the 12th March 1807
