Greenville District wherein Rebecca Tillman lastly died Lying on  
both sides of Cane fork of S. Tyger river Beginning on a large  
Poplar near the Saluda path running thence N. 30 E. 236 ft. 60 th.  
to a Red Oak thence N. 85 E. 59 ch. to a Stake thence S. 70 W. 86 ch. to a  
Stake thence S. 75 W. 26 ch. to a W. Oak thence S. 33 E. 35 ch. 56 ft.  
to a Stake thence N. 77 W. 73 ch. to the Beginning supposed to con-  
tain Two Hundred Acres or the same more or less it being a  
Tract of land originally granted to Alex<sup>n</sup> Camlin from his Con-  
v<sup>n</sup> to to Dennis Loring by which means it has fell into my  
hands together with all & singular the Right Men have heretofore  
unto & appertaining to Belonging or in any wise incident  
to the same to have & to hold all & singular the before described  
premises unto him the said Alex<sup>n</sup> Camlin his Heirs Executors Ad-  
ministrators for ever & I do hereby bind my self my heirs Exe<sup>t</sup>  
& Administrators to WARRANT & for Ever defend all & singular the before  
mentioned Premises unto the said Alex<sup>n</sup> Camlin or his Heirs or assigns  
for ever Against my self my heirs or any other Person whom  
soever lawfully claiming or to obtain the same or any part  
thereof witness my hand & Seal this Twenty Third day of March in  
the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred & Eighteen &  
42<sup>nd</sup> year of American Independence signed sealed & executed in the presence
