 unto the P. James Rice his heirs & assigns for ever and if  
 Jacob Cooley do hereby bind myself my heirs Administrators  
 & assigns to warrant & for ever defend the S. Premises unto the  
 P. James Rice his heirs Administrators & assigns against my  
 self & my heirs & against every other person Whomesoever Law-  
 fully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof with-  
 out my hand & seal this Twentieth day of November Eighteen  
 Hundred & Eleven in the thirty sixth Year of the American Indep-  
 endency signed sealed & delivered in the presence of us Interland

 Released unto the said Jacob Rice all that tract or parcel of land  
 containing fifty Acres be the same more or less Situate in the  
 State & District aforesaid on the waters of Rocky fork of Golden  
 Grove Creek it being part of a tract of Land Granted to Richard  
 Good beginning on a Red Oak & running from thence N. 25 E. to  
 a post Oak & from thence W. 65 S to a Branch of Rocky fork from  
 thence down said branch to the main fork from thence down said  
 fork to David Rice's corner White Oak from thence along a  
 Conditional line to the beginning. together with all & singular  
 the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said  
 premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining  
 to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned  
 unto the said Jacob Rice his heirs & assigns for ever &
