of Charleston did by my certain deed or instrument of writing bearing
date about the day of in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and ninety eight, grant bargain sell and release unto Philip
Howorth a certain Plantation or tract of Land hereinafter to be
described, of which said Plantation or tract of land the said Philip How-
orth took possession and hath held an uninterrupted possession thereof
from that time till the present: But his not having duly recorded
the said Deed, the same hath since been either lost or mislaid.
NOW therefore in order to secure and fully to warrant & protect
the said Philip Howorth in his right & title to the said Plantation or
tract of land, above alluded to, and hereinafter to be fully described.
Know all men by these presents that I the said John Johnson in
consideration of the sum of Five dollars to me in Hand paid by
the said Philip Howorth, as also of the Premises aforesaid
have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Philip Howorth
All that Plantation or tract of Land containing two hundred &
twenty five acres more or less, on a branch of Desbris Creek
below the Indian Boundary, Situate lying and being in Twenty six
district, now Greenville District, on North of Saluda River: Bounded on
the North East on Matthias Armstrongs land, on the East on Richard
Fowlers land, and on all other sides on Vacant land, as appears
