

I do hereby acknowledge hath bargained sold and confirmed & Conveyed unto the said William Hawkins his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the district aforesaid on the waters of Saluda containing twenty five acres being part of a tract of land Conveyed by George Salmon to Harriett Ford, Beginning at a Chestnut Stake Corner on said Hawkins line running to John Vaughan line, thence with with said line to a Stake Corner on said line, then with a Stake line cross the Spring branch to a post Oak Corner then to Rock corner, then to a Pine Corner on John Bates line from thence to the beginning on said Hawkins line, Containing twenty five acres, To have and to hold the bargained premises, and I do here by for myself my heirs executors and administrators Warrant and forever defend against all person or persons claiming the same.
