

Front on main Street and one hundred and seventy six & one fourth feet deep. Begening at a Stake corner on main Street running thence South Twenty four degrees East one hundred and seventy six and one fourth feet to a Stake thence South Sixteen degrees West one hundred feet to a Stake thence N. 74 W. 176 $\frac{1}{4}$ feet to a Stake on main Street, thence N. Sixteen degrees East 100 feet to the begining : Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining ; To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Benajah Dunham his Heirs and Assigns forever. And I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Benajah Dunham his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other Person or Persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any Part thereof. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this thirteenth day of February, in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Nineteen.
