Thompson wife of the within mentioned Waddy Thompson, did this day appear before me, and upon being privately and separately examined by me, did declare, that she does, fully, voluntarily, and without any compulsion, duad or fear, of any person, or persons, whomsoever, renounce, release, & power relinquish, unto the within named Jeremiah Cleveland, and to his heirs & assigns, all her interest & estate also all her right and claim of dower, of, in, or to all and singular, the premises within mentioned and released. 40 The State of South Carolina Thru all men by this presents that I Garland of the district of Sumville and state aforesaid planter for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Jeremiah Cleveland of the same place Merchant, have granted bargained sold and released and by this presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland a certain piece or parcel of land containing ten acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the district and state aforesaid on the north east side of Rudy River. Beginning at a Stake corner, near a red oak, on the east bank of the river where Carters old line crosses running thence with his line South thirty degrees east twenty one chains and seventy five links to a stake on E. Greens line
