Walker's survey thence N 38° E $22\frac{1}{2}W$, Walker's old line, to a red oak corner thence N 76° W $36\frac{1}{2}W$. 50 links to a rock conditional corner on a little branch thence down said branch which is a conditional line to the creek thence down the creek 2 ch s . 79 lk s to a rock conditional corner on the west side of the creek thence S $36W$ 1 chain to a white oak bush a conditional corner thence S 82° W $3ch$. 12 links to a red oak sapling a conditional corner thence N 84° W $3ch$. 2 to a red oak sapling a conditional corner on the ridge thence along on the top of the ridge in a western direction until it intersects with Martin Adams old line thence S $20^{\circ}W$ along said line to a stake thence S 58° E $35ch$ to the beginning poplar corner containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres, be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights & members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise belonging or appertaining thereto. To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned, to the said Elizabeth Hightower and Jane Hightower themselves their heirs & assigns forever. And I the said Alfred Hightower do hereby bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises to the said Elizabeth Hightower & Jane Hightower their heirs & assigns, against myself my heirs and assigns, and from all and every person a person, whatsoever laying any lawful claim to the same or any part thereof.
