137 State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I John  
Sims of Greenville district in the State aforesaid in consideration of five  
hundred & fifty dollars to me paid have granted, bargained, sold, and  
released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto  
Samuel Howard of the State and district aforesaid a tract or parcel  
of land lying on Durbins creek waters of noice river. Beginning at a  
gum corner near the old line path and runs S<sup>o</sup> to a red oak corner X 3  
On the said Samuel Howards line thence E<sup>o</sup> along said Howards line  
to a pine corner X 3 from thence S<sup>o</sup> along said Howards line to a white  
oak corner X 3 thence along said Howards line across the creek to  
a post oak corner X 3 thence along said Howards line to a white  
oak corner near the creek thence along W<sup>m</sup> Goldsmiths <sup>line</sup> to a  
corner near said Goldsmiths fence thence along a line of markers  
near Joseph McNeelys fence to a post oak stump X 3 thence  
along said Joseph McNeelys line to a post oak corner near a  
red bank in said McNeelys field thence along said McNeelys  
line across the branch to a stone corner near the ford of the branch  
thence up the north side of a little branch to a red oak corner  
on said McNeelys corner thence along said Joseph McNeelys  
line to a stake corner thence west to the beginning: Containing  
all the tract of land whereon said John Sims now lives except  
what has formerly been conveyed to Joseph McNeely, said  
land containing by estimation one hundred & fifty acres  
be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights  
members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and  
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Howard  
his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs &c  
Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises  
unto the said Samuel Howard his heirs and assigns against my self &  
my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming  
or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand & seal  
this 4<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord 1820. And in the 44<sup>th</sup> year  
of the Independence of the United States of America.
