that I Thos^r. Hutchings of the district and state aforesaid for and
in consideration of the sum of two hundred & fifty dollars to
Geo. T. Sloan (Sadler), of Laurens district by two notes of hand
with interest, reference being therunto had, will now fully and
at large appear, have granted, bargained, and sold & mortgaged
and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell & mortgage unto
the said Geo. T. Sloan his heirs, exec^r, adm^r, or assigns a certain
cotton Factory in the district and state aforesaid on Enoree river
containing as follows: One spinning frame, two roaping heads & four
drawing heads, and two cards, also three cows and three calves. —
I have and to hold all & singular the said materials of said Factory
with said cattle unto the said Geo. T. Sloan his heirs, exec^r, adm^r or assigns
forever. And I do hereby warrant & give defend the right of said
mortgaged property to the said George T. Sloan &c. and against myself
my heirs, executors, administrators or assigns and against all & every
other person claiming the same or any part thereof. Provided always
never the less that if the above bound Thomas Hutchings his heirs Executors
Administrators or assigns, shall well and truly pay the above notes one
of said Notes on or before next Christmas the other note the Christmas
following in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred & Twenty one
then the above mortgage shall be entirely void and of no effect, but if any
thing should happen to the contrary, that then it shall be lawful for
the said George T. Sloan his heirs executors, Administrators or assigns
to sell or dispose of the same for the payment of the above debt. In Witness
hereof I have set my hand and Seal this 11th day of March in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty, and in the forty fourth
Year of the Independence of America. Signed Sealed & Delivered
