Fennell of Greenville district and state aforesd. for & in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Hugh Robertson of Greenville district and state aforesaid Have granted bargained, sold, & released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell & release, unto the said Hugh Robertson a lot of land #18 lying within the late plan of the village of Greenville, near the rock spring. Beginning on the corner of main cross & canal street, at a stake running N16W 200 feet to a stake; thence N74W 200 feet to a stake: thence N16E 200 feet to a stake; thence S74E 200 to the beginning. Together with all & singular the rights, members, h indentments & appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining: To have & to hold the above mentioned premises. And I the said Hardy L. Fennell for myself, my heirs, executors & adm^r. do hereby warrant and defend the above mentioned premises to the said Hugh Robertson his heirs or assigns Forever against myself, my heirs & against every person lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. Hester lying & being in the district and state aforesaid on the waters of Richland creek a water of ready now, having such marks, bounds &c. as follows. Beginning on a red oak corner on the Spartanburg road near Lester shop thence S29E16W 25 links to a white oak at a spring of water thence down the branch 10 chl. to a stake on E. Gruns line thence N65E2ch 25 links to a hickory C. Gruns corner thence S30E crossing a branch 16 chl 50 lk^s to a stake on the original line thence N65E crossing
