granted a privilege to John Bale to raise and occupy a wor-  
kshop and adjacent buildings on her Land situated between  
her dwelling house and the village of Greenville for the  
State of South Carolina the term of one year and six months from  
the date hereof at the expiration of  
which time or any other time should the  
said Lydia Hornbuckle require his removal she shall  
give him three months notice of her intention and he  
shall be at liberty to remove his buildings & improvements  
free of any charges from the said Lydia Hornbuckle
