the tract of land that I give to my son Iffre Edwards supposed
to be fifty acres more or less Beginning on a branch on the North
Bank of South Tyger River Running from thence N^o 28 & a
4th degree West to a pine tree N^o 24 Degrees west to the line
between line of Parsons Originally Survey at or near the corner
there L^o & S^W crossing the river to Robert Carter former line
thence with the said Carter line to a gum corner on the
South side of said river from thence to the beginning
Down the meanders of the river containing fifty acres more
less it Being part of a tract of land Granted to Major
Parsons from him to Thomas Todd from him to John Thoms
from him to William D. Thomas from him to Thomas
Edwards from him to his son Iffre Edwards & from him back
to his Father Thomas with land being & lying in Greenville
