or secured to be paid, by the said James Green, the receipt  
and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted,  
bargained, and sold and by these presents do grant bargain &  
sell unto the said James Green his heirs & assigns forever, the said  
tract, piece and parcel of land, with its appurtenances & all  
the estate, right, title and interest, which the said Thos. Under  
wood of right had, or, in, & to the same. To have & to hold the said  
piece, parcel & tract of land, with its appurtenances, unto the  
said James Green his heirs and assigns forever, as fully & absolute  
& by as I the said Asa W. Crowder might, could, or ought to grant,  
bargain & sell the same, by virtue of the statute aforesaid, &  
the said writ of fieri facias or otherwise. In witness whereof,  
I the said Asa W. Crowder have hereunto set my hand and seal,  
the sixth day of August in the year four thousand one thousand eight  
hundred and twenty one. Sealed, signed & delivered in the presence of
