 to hold the said property, unto the said Joseph Smith his heirs  
 and assigns forever. And I James Cannon for myself my heirs  
 & assigns do hereby warrant & forever defend the sale of said  
 bargained property unto the said Jo<sup>s</sup>. Smith clear & free from all  
 claims or demands of any other person or persons whatsoever  
 claiming or demanding of any other person or persons whatsoever
