State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I William Wood of Greenville district & State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred & thirty dollars to me in hand paid by John Petty Pool of the district & state aforesaid have bargained sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said John Petty Pool all that tract or parcel of land containing, one hundred & ten acres be the same more or less beginning on a red oak corner S. Side of Beaverdam Creek running N. 63 East to the Creek thence down the meanders of S. Creek to the mouth of a branch to a white wood corner thence up S. branch to a maple corner thence S. 30° 90' to a light wood stake & thence S. 63 W. to a Spanish oak thence N. 27 W. to the beginning. Together with all & singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise appertaining to have & to hold all & singular premises before mentioned unto the said John Petty Pool his heirs executors or any of them to warrant & forever defend all & singularly the said premises unto the said John Petty Pool his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. witness my hand & seal this 30th May 1808.

State of South Carolina Greenville district Know all men by these presents, that I Benajah Cannaday of the state & district aforesaid have granted bargained & sold & by these presents do grant, bargain sell & convey to Triplet Cannaday, all that Tract of land containing, one hundred & fifty five acres be the same more or less- for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by the s^r Triplet Cannaday, of the state and district aforesaid lying on both sides little Martin's Creek beginning on a black oak dead near George Lyons fence running thence S. 80 E. 66.50 ft post oak thence N. 38 W. 18 to Stake 3 & thence N. 10. 63 to Stake on Abner Jones line thence S. 20 W. 30 ft to the beginning which includes the land sold & conveyed by the same man or less the land conveyed was originally granted to William Steel lying on John Cannaday Edward Howard George Lyons & Abner Jones- Together with all & singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances thereto ¹⁴⁶ unto belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining thereto unto the only proper use & behoof of him the s^r Triplet Cannaday.
