The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I  
J. A. Pollard of the district of Greenville in the state afo<sup>r</sup> in consideration  
of the Sum of five hundred & fifty dollars to me in hand paid by  
John Ashmore sen<sup>r</sup> of the district of Greenville in the State afo<sup>r</sup> said  
have granted bargain sold & released & by these presents do grant  
bargain sell & release unto the said John Ashmore sen<sup>r</sup> all that  
tract or parcel of land containing one hundred & fifty five acres  
more or less lying in the district of Greenville on both sides of Pyles  
branch waters of Udy River the said land being part of a tract  
originally granted to Kemna Hudson & signed by his Excellency Ben<sup>o</sup>  
Gerard on the 15<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1784 and a part granted to Hame Black and  
signed by his Excellency Thomas Parkey on the 1<sup>st</sup> Oct. 1787 & a part  
granted to John Thomas J<sup>r</sup> & signed by his Excellency Edw<sup>d</sup>. Rutledge  
on the 5<sup>th</sup> Jan<sup>y</sup> 1799 and a part granted to John Pyle as referred  
to the grant, beginning on a Sweet gum on the South Side of  
the Udy fork waters of Udy River thence running westward  
39 Ch<sup>ns</sup> to a Pine 3x thence S. Eastward to a Stake 3x thence running  
5 & a half Chain to Pyle branch thence up said branch to a  
Poplar stump near Ben<sup>o</sup> Pollard's Mill thence a long a Condit  
-ional line to a Stake 3x thence S. 40 W to a hickory corner  
thence S 30 E 9 Chain 75 links to a black oak 3x thence N 40 E  
22 Chain to Pyles branch, thence running N 70 E a long John  
Alexander line to the Udy fork Creek, thence running up said  
Creek & binding on the same to the beginning 3x including  
one hundred & fifty five acres of land more or less Together with  
all and singular the rights Members hereditaments to the said  
Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining  
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before men  
-tioned unto the said John Ashmore sen<sup>r</sup> his heirs & assigns  
forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & adminis  
-trators to Warrant & forever defend, all and singular the  
Said premises unto the said John Ashmore sen<sup>r</sup> his heirs and  
assigns against myself my heirs & assigns & against every  
other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the  
Same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have set my  
hand & Seal 29<sup>th</sup> December 1821.
