I know all men by these presents that I
John McLanahan of the district of Greenville
in the state aforesaid for and in consideration
of a negro woman named Helly to me sold and
and delivered by Thomas G Walker of the District
aforesaid. State aforesaid have granted a bargain
sold released and conveyed and by these presents
do grant bargain sell release and convey unto
the said Thomas G Walker his heirs and assigns
all that plantation tract or parcel of Land
on which I now live situated in the district aforesaid
on the waters of Rudey River being composed of
two tracts, or parcels; one conveyed to me by Joseph
Bridges of one hundred and nine acres, being
part of a tract granted to Thomas Lockett of
two hundred and eighteen acres having such
shape markers buildings and boundings as are
represented in the plat to the original grant
conceded, and in the deed of conveyance from
Joseph Bridges to me as by reference thereto
may fully appear; the other part or tract con-
veyed to trustees for my use life of and limits
by Solomon Langston on the second day of November
-ber 1809 and wherein particularly described
as a inference thereto will Shaw and Containing
according to the said deed forty four acres; the
whole containing by estimation one hundred and
forty acres more or less to gether with all ~~and~~
the right number hereditaments and appurten-
ances there unto belonging in any wise in
Court or appertaining; to have and to hold
all and singular the premises above-
