

That plantation parcel or tract of Land

and acres; being part of a tract granted
to Thomas Lohr of two hundred and
Eighteen acres having such shape, main
cuttings and boundaries as represented in
the plat annexed to the original grant and
in the deed of conveyance from Joseph
Bridges, to John McBlanchan as by reference
thereto will more fully appear; the other
part a tract, conveyed to trustees for the
use of the said John McBlanchan by Solo-
-man Langston on the second day of Novem-
-ber 1819 and therein particularly described
as reference thereto will show, and containing
to the said deed forty four acres the whole
containing by estimation one hundred and forty
by a acre more or less; Together with all the
rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenan-
-ces thereto belonging, or in any wise in-
-cident or appertaining to have and
to hold all and singular, the premises
afore mentioned unto the said Jacob Earnest
his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby
bind bind my self my Executors administrators
and assigns, to warrant and for ever defend,
all and singular the said premises to the said
Jacob Earnest—his heirs and assigns and a-
-gainst my self and my heirs and against
Every person whomsoever lawfully claiming
or to claim the same or any part thereof
