make a deed of gift to my son Larkin Cannon
of the State and District aforesaid to a tract of a tract
of land lying on S. Edger River known by the name of
Wellford Branch, beginning on the Bank of the River
at a black Horn & Possum corner running down S.
River to David Martel's Land a long marshy line
of the branch leaving Martel's Land up the branch
through the plantation to my own Land a long
my line to a black Jack corner on Porters Land
thence a long Porters Land to the beginning corner on S.
River we still make a reserve of the apple orchard & the land
on the side of branch running through S. plantation


For our own use and purpose so long as we please,
Taking in one hundred acres be the same more or less
to gether with all and singular the rights heretofore
and appertaining to said Land belonging or in
any wise incident or appertaining to it and
to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned to the said Larkin Cannon his heirs and
assigns forever & I do bind ourselves our heirs assigns
forever & I do bind ourselves our heirs assigns Executors
and Administrators to warrant and defend
all and singular the premises before mentioned
against myself my heirs and assigns or any other
person or persons lawfully claiming the same
or my part there of witness our hands and seals this
22 Octuber 1821 signed sealed and delivered in
