in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred and Twenty at the
Court of Andover butlers, to me directed
Commanding me, that of the goods and chattels
of her land and tenement of James Porter & wife
to levy the sum of One hundred and twenty nine
dollars eleven cents, damage and costs, share, due
and taken of the lands and tenements
of the said James Porter & wife, all that certain
piece, parcel and tract of land, con-
taining four Hundred and Twenty six
acres, situate and being in the District of
Greenville aforesaid on the north side of
South Tyger River, bounded by lands of
Thomas Edwards & James Smith & Henry
Brown, being the tract whereon the
James Porter now lives and having
