Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Matlock of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of three hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by Levi Lovelopf of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargained sold, and released by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Levi Lovelopf all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred and ten acres more or less situate in Greenville District lying the south west branch of Horse Creek Beginning on a stake 3^t in the fork of a branch and little Horse creek running thence \$40 £40.50 to a white oak 3^t bounding on Benj: Arnold to the Indian boundary line thence \$47 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. \$35.00 on said line to a postmark 3^t thence N 33 W 9. 35 to a white oak 3^t at the head of a branch thence down the meanders of said branch to the beginning together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Levi Lovelopf his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Levi Lovelopf against my self and my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
