of the District of Greenville & State aforesaid for & in
consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars
to me in hand Paid by Benj^r. Pollard Junr. of the
State and District aforesaid have granted bargained
and released & by these presents do grant bargain sell &
release to the said Benj^r. Pollard Jr one hundred &
sixty acres of land in the same more or less the said
land lying on the south side of Pyles Branch waters
of Rudy River originally granted to the said J. A. Pollard
and his wife by his Excellency Joseph Alston on the 17 November
1814. and layd out as follows. begining on a pine not corner
on Thompson Dickersons line thence N 65. W to a hickory corner
near William Cottons Spring thence S 30 E 16. 70 to a R 03 & then
S 090. W 15. 20 to chestnut 3X thence S 30 E 39. 20 to the said J. Dickins
-ons. 3X thence N. Ewardly ~~a corner of~~ ^{to} Dickersons line
to the beginning including one hundred & sixty acres of
land more or less to gether with all and singular the
rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the
said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appur-
taining to have and to hold all and singular the premises
before mentioned unto the said Benj^r. Pollard Jr his heirs
and assigns for ever. and I do here by bind my self my heirs
and executors to warrant and forever defend the
same unto Benj^r. Pollard Jr his heirs & assigns against
my self my heirs and assigns & every other person or per-
sons what soever lawfully claiming or to claim any part
there of In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal
